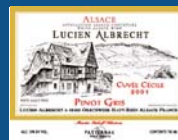

Maison Lucien Albrecht is among the pioneers of viticulture in Alsace. Beginning in 1425, Romanus Albrecht established the family in Alsace in the town of Thann near the Swiss border. In 1678, Balthazar Albrecht moved the family to Orschwir and the modern period began.

Today, the Domaine Lucien Albrecht is located in Orschwir and in nine surrounding villages. The domaine consists of a majority holding of the Grand Cru Pfingstberg, large parcels of the Bollenberg cru overlooking the town and origin of the special cuvees of Pinot Gris “Cecile” and Gewürztraminer “Marie” and three “clos”: Clos Schild Riesling, Clos Himmelreich Riesling and Clos des Recollets Pinot Gris.

Jean Albrecht, the family’s eighteenth generation, heads the firm today and is the firm’s chief winemaker and vineyard manager whose goal is to always “respect the grapes” and to respect nature.

The Albrecht’s believe Alsace is truly one of the most versatile and exciting white wine producing regions in the world.

Lucien Albrecht "Reserve" wines are carefully vinified from grapes grown both by Maison Albrecht and by neighboring "vignerons" under long-term contract and supervision of Jean Albrecht. The Special Cuvees are hand-crafted from exclusively domaine-grown fruit. The two grands crus are the pinnacle of Alsace quality. They are perfect expressions of an exceptional terroir, the Pfingstberg vineyard, and are among the greatest white wines produced in France from any vineyard region.
