The Dauré family has long been acknowledged as the premier winemaking family of Côtes du Roussillon. Their holdings are comprised Château de Jau, Les Clos de Pauilles.

Built in 1792, Château de Jau is located in the southernmost foothills of the Roussillon slopes of the Corbières Mountains in French Catalonia. Today, the estate produces Côtes du Roussillon Villages Rouge, Côtes du Roussillon Blanc, Muscat de Rivesaltes, along with the lovely wines known as "le Jaja de Jau."



The estate spans the villages of Cases de Pène, Estagel, and Tautavel, occupying 134 cultivated hectares planted in eleven classic Mediterranean varietals.

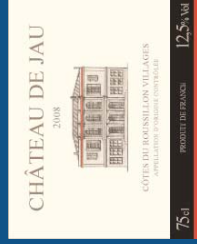

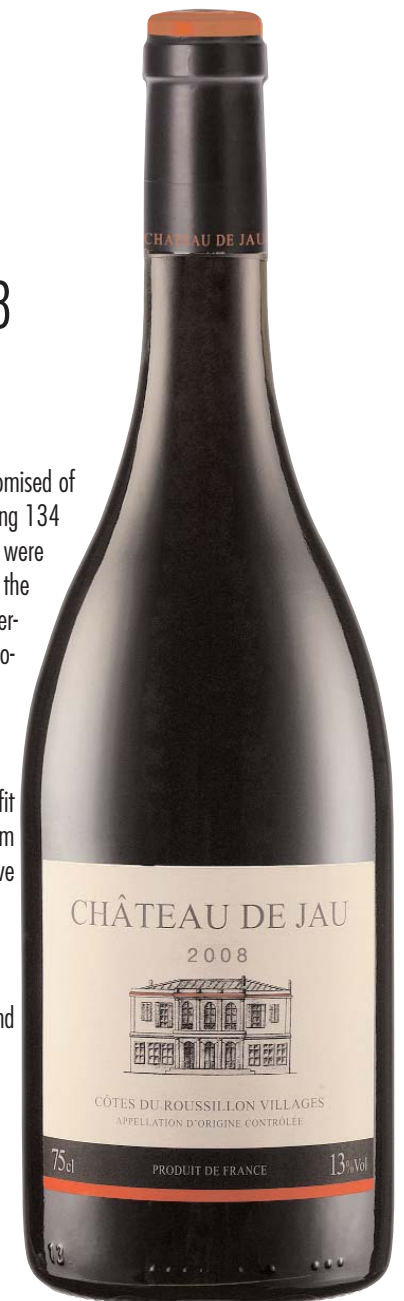
HARVEST & AGEING

Each varietal is hand harvested and vinified separately in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks. Grenache and Carignan benefit from a two-week skin contact maceration. Syrah and Mourvedre are vinified in rotating fermenters for a full week, yielding maximum richness and extraction. This provides for high quality, soft, ripe tannins. The aged in vats and bottled without oak ageing to preserve the natural style and concentration.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Dark red in color, with intense, ripe berry-tobacco aromas and a generous perfumed bouquet. Concentrated flavors supported by sound acidity and a long, sustained finish.

Grapes Varieties: 45% Syrah, 30% Mourvedre, 10% Grenache Noir, 15% Carignan

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HARVEST & AGEING

80% of the harvest is destemmed and benefits from extended skin contact before being pressed and then fermented. Neutral grape spirit is then added in the process known as "mutage" to this fermenting clear "must" resulting in the maximum retention of fresh fruit aroma flavor and structure. The remaining 20% of the harvest is fermented and processed before pressing in order to provide tannic support.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Deep bright golden-yellow with hallmark aromas of fresh honey and apricot, luscious, rich full flavors and an endless finish.

Grape: 100% Muscat "Petits Grains"

THE VINEYARD

Château de Jau Grand Roussillon is owned and managed by the Dauré family. The vineyard is located in the foothills of the Pyrenees in an area known as the Alberes on ancient slate terraces. The vineyards face southeast toward the Mediterranean and are located at the extremities of the appellations of Banyuls and Rivesaltes, producing delicious desert wines, singular due to their extreme southern exposure.

HARVEST & AGEING

The entire vineyard is hand harvested and the grapes de-stemmed. Skin contact in the vat for 3 days, prior to fermentation. Before completion of fermentation process, the wines are pressed and fortified with 9% neutral grape alcohol. The wines are clarified by natural gravity flow then aged in new Bordeaux barriques for 3 years. An additional 3-4 months of aging in the bottle in temperature controlled cellars before shipping.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Light amber color. Tastes and smells of orange marmalade. Excellent balance of sugar, tannin, acidity and alcohol. Enjoy this rare treat as a dessert on its own, with chocolate or with candied citrus confections.

THE VINEYARD

What does "JAJA" mean?:

"Jaja is a slang for the region's delicious full-flavored, everyday wines. It is the house selection in local bistros and restaurants. The Label was designed by Benjamin Vauthier - founder of the "fluxxes" movement in contemporary and graphic art.

HARVEST & AGEING

Harvested along with the wines for its older brother, Cotes du Roussillon Village Rouge and blended with wines from neighboring vineyards. Jaja is vinified to preserve all the ripe fruit of each vintage. Bottled early to preserve bright fresh fruit flavors.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

A chunky, peppery red with smoky kirsch/blackcurrant and herbs de Provence scents; delicate floral nose, well-balanced tannins and acid; hints of raspberry on the palate; light, simple, and straightforward.

Grape Varieties: 100% Syrah

Alc%: 13%

THE VINEYARD

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The JAJA Range is designed to be fun and youthful. Whilst meeting consumer standards in terms of quality, JAJA's link to the renowned Château de JAU, both in terms of source of grapes and historical winemaking, provide strength of credibility and worldwide success as a unique, innovative and artistic concept that is SO easy to remember.

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HARVEST & AGEING

Short skin maceration for up to 6 hours, first free juice is then vinified at low temperature to ensure a perfect balance and bright colour. It is bottled early to enhance the freshness and hint of white pepper spiciness of the fruit.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

This rosé, rich in red berry fruit (raspberry and strawberry), cherries and blackcurrant, has a lively and slightly effervescent palate with a full bodied and clean crisp finish.

THE VINEYARD

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HARVEST & AGEING

Skin contact fermentation with regular stirring of the lees. Stored for up to 3 to 4 months on the fine lees in temperature controlled stainless steel vat to enhance the true fresh fruit base, so important for the Sauvignon grape variety.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Very aromatic nose of white flowers and buds of blackcurrant. In the mouth, it is crisp, fresh and zesty, with a citrus hint of honeyed grapefruit, lively and long. Great Sauvignon typicality!

Grape Varieties: 100% Sauvignon Blanc

Alc%: 11.5%

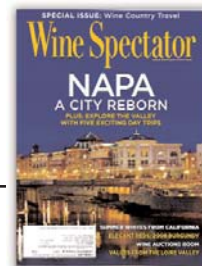

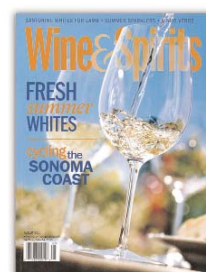
