Maison Lucien Albrecht is among the pioneers of viticulture in Alsace. Beginning in 1425, Romanus Albrecht established the family in Alsace in the town of Thann near the Swiss border. In 1698, Balthazar Albrecht moved the family to Orschwir and the modern period began.

Today, the Domaine Lucien Albrecht is located in Orschwir and in nine surrounding villages. The domaine consists of a majority holding of the Grand Cru Pfingsberg, large parcels of the Bollenberg cru overlooking the town and origin of the special cuvees of Pinot Gris "Cecile" and Gewürztraminer "Marie" and three "clos": Clos Schild Riesling, Clos Himmelreich Riesling and Clos des Recollets Pinot Gris.

Jean Albrecht, the family's eighteenth generation, heads the firm today and is the firm's chief winemaker and vineyard manager whose goal is to always "respect the grapes" and to respect nature.

The Albrecht's believe Alsace is truly one of the most versatile and exciting white wine producing regions in the world.

Lucien Albrecht "Reserve" wines are carefully vinified from grapes grown both by Maison Albrecht and by neighboring "vignerons" under long-term contract and supervision of Jean Albrecht. The Special Cuvees are hand-crafted from exclusively domaine-grown fruit. The two grands crus are the pinnacle of Alsace quality. They are perfect expressions of an exceptional terroir, the Pfingsberg vineyard, and are among the greatest white wines produced in France from any vineyard region.

Cuvée Balthazar Pinot Blanc 2010

THE VINEYARD

The Pinot Blanc Cuvée Balthazar is named for Balthazar Albrecht who settled in Orschwihr in 1698.

Maison Albrecht is a family owned and managed winery founded in 1425 now its eighteenth generation. The estate includes some of the most prestigious terroirs in Alsace including vineyards and monopoles in the Grand Crus Pfingstberg and several Clos, Clos Schild, Clos Himmelreich, Clos des Récollets. Lucien Albrecht's vineyards are meticulously cared for.

HARVEST & AGEING

The harvest is a manual harvest with no de-stemming, the whole bunches go into the press. The pressing is low and soft and last for several hours. Followed by a temperature controlled fermentation.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

This wine, made 100% from Pinot Blanc, is unoaked and fresh with a soft dry fruit. It is the wine to drink at home as an aperitif or with all casual family meals. Picked when very mature, harmonious with a lively spring finesse.

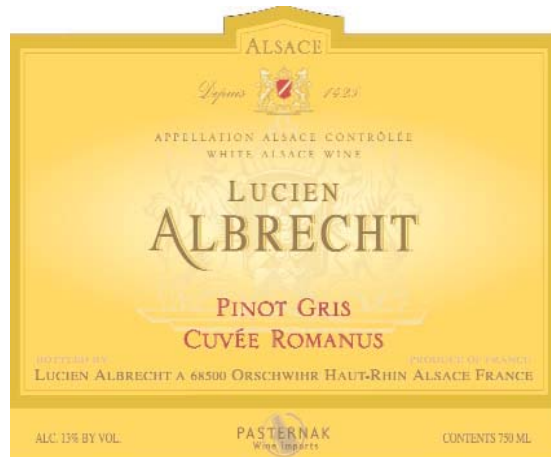

HARVEST & AGEING

The harvest is a manual harvest with no destemming, the whole bunches go into the press. The pressing is low and soft and last for several hours. Followed by a temperature controlled fermentation.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

This wine, made 100% from Pinot Gris, expresses the rich yet dry power and character of this exceptional varietal. The clay/limestone soil gives a creamy, velvety wine with a long finish.

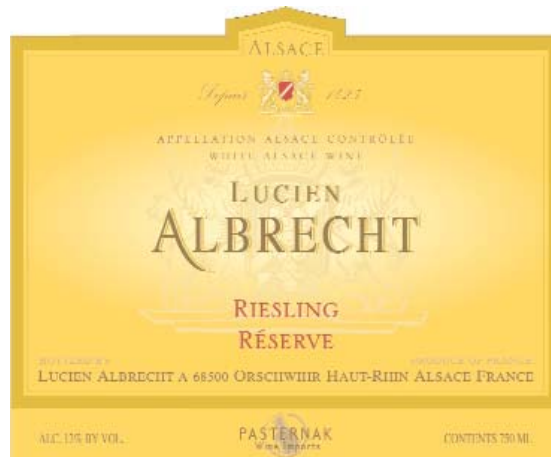

Riesling Réserve is made from their best selection of this noble varietal. The wine is 100% Riesling and is distinguished by a piercing and beautiful aroma suggesting spring flowers. The wine is bone dry and delicious. The Riesling is considered the signature wine of the Albrecht family. Quick, floral and mineral smell, it reveals itself slightly spiced and elegant in the mouth.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The Gewurztraminer Reserve is made from selected (prime) grapes. Bursting with the aroma of honey, red roses and tropical fruit, yet dry and rich on the palate, this wine is lovely to drink on a warm afternoon by itself or paired in a meal with rich, creamy poultry dishes. It releases both to the mouth and the nose litchi, rose petal and spice aroma.

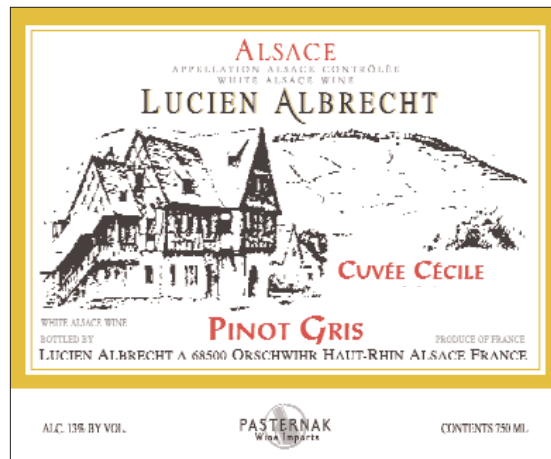

THE VINEYARD

Cuvée Cecile is named for Cecile Albrecht, one of the two daughters of Jean Albrecht.

Maison Albrecht is a family owned and managed winery founded in 1425 now its ninth generation. The estate includes some of the most prestigious terroirs in Alsace including vineyards and monopoles in the Grand Crus Pfingstberg and several Clos, Clos Schild, Clos Himmelreich, Clos des Récollets. Lucien Albrecht's vineyards are meticulously cared for.

HARVEST & AGEING

This finely crafted wine is made from old vine vineyards carefully selected at the time of harvest. This cuvée is dense and concentrated. The harvest is a manual harvest and a slow soft pneumatic pressing. Fermentation last for three months. Aging "sur lie". For the Pinot Gris, once a week they do a "batonnage" stirring of the fine lees.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

This wine is rich and complex with ripe fruit flavor. It is an elegant wine with breed and finesse, hint of spices and rosewater.

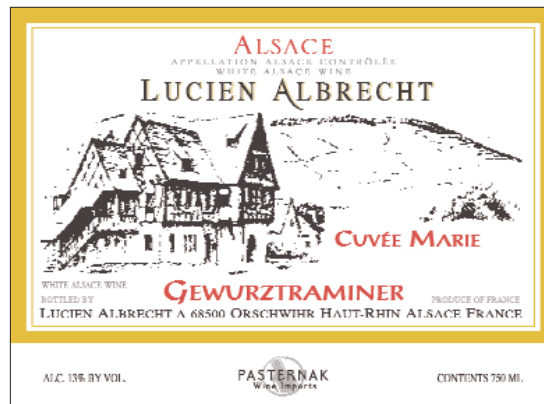

The estate includes some of the most prestigious terroirs in Alsace including vineyards and monopoles in the Grand Crus Pfingstberg and several Clos, Clos Schild, Clos Himmelreich, Clos des Récollets. Lucien Albrecht's vineyards are meticulously cared for.

HARVEST & AGEING

This finely crafted wine is made from old vine vineyards from a careful selection at the time of harvest. This cuvée is dense and concentrated. The harvest is a manual harvest and a slow soft pneumatic pressing. Fermentation last for three months. Aging "sur lie".

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

A seductive wine with aromas of quince, honey and exotic spices. Luscious and broad with finesse and a long finish.

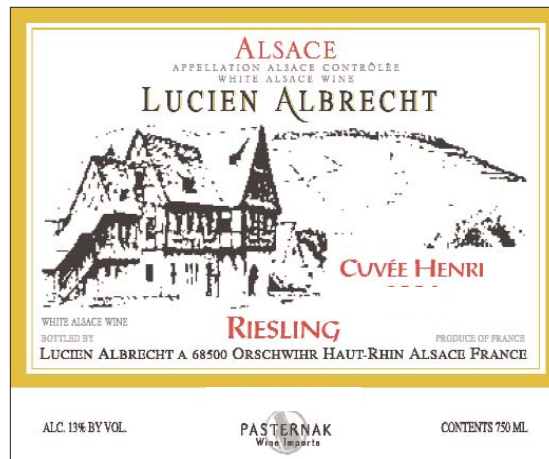

Cuvée Henri Riesling 2009

THE VINEYARD

Cuvée Henri is named for Henri Albrecht, the grandfather of Jean Albrecht.

Maison Albrecht is a family owned and managed winery founded in 1425 now its ninth generation. The estate includes some of the most prestigious terroirs in Alsace including vineyards and monopoles in the Grand Crus Pfingstberg and several Clos, Clos Schild, Clos Himmelreich, Clos des Récollets. Lucien Albrecht's vineyards are meticulously cared for.

HARVEST & AGEING

This finely crafted wine is made from old vine vineyards, between 35 to 40 years old, hand picked blocks from a careful selection at the time of harvest. This cuvée is dense and concentrated. The harvest is a manual harvest and a slow soft pneumatic pressing. Fermentation last for three months. After the alcoholic fermentation, gravity racking, we keep the fine lees for batonnage for few months, Aging "sur lie". Vinification in temperature controlled stainless steel vat. The harvest of the grapes was spread from the 10 to the 15 of October.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Cuvée Henri offers rich extract of Riesling fruit while providing a well balanced interplay of the fruit and acid strength which yields a long mouth filling experience.

Once a week for six months they do a "batonnage" stirring of the fine lees.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

This wine has a beautiful balance, between the over-ripeness aromas, the rich fruit with notes of honey, vanilla and hint of smokiness. This is a wine worth ageing.
