HARVEST & AGEING

The grapes are sourced from the 9 year old vineyards in the Vistalba region, in the Lujan district of Mendoza about 3,000 feet above sea-level. Hand-tended and hand-harvested, the Rutini family's high altitude vineyards provide the foundation for Trumpeter. Destemmed for a 15 day fermentation and maceration. Ageing takes place for 7 months in 20% new American oak and 20% in new French oak, 60% second and third use American oak. 100% malolactic fermentation.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Inky and dense with attractive berry aromas and a touch of cinnamon and sweet spice. A fully, fruity wine, with excellent body, intense tannins, flavors of cherry, blackberry, boysenberry and plum intermingled with hints of cardamom and pepper, and a long, full finish.

Ageing takes place for 7 months in 20% new American oak, 20% new French oak and 60% second and third use French oak. 100% malolactic fermentation.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Concentrated but supple with aromas of crushed berries, chocolate, and tobacco. Complex flavors of berry fruit, with gamey and toasty notes, sweet, smooth tannins and good length.

Grape Varieties: 50% Malbec, 50% Syrah

Finished Alcohol: 13.5%

Acidity/pH: 4.95 g/l/3.8

HARVEST & AGEING

The grapes are sourced from 40 year old vineyards in Tupungato, a region high in the Andes Mountains. The climate consists of bright sunny days, cool nights and a mild harvest, which allows for gradual ripening and optimum level of maturity. Hand-tended and hand-harvested, the Rutini family's high altitude vineyards provide the foundation for Trumpeter. The grapes are destemmed after 23 day fermentation and maceration. Ageing took place for 7 months in 50% new American oak and 50% in second and third year French oak. 100% malolactic fermentation.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Trumpeter Merlot displays concentrated aromas of blackberries, black cherries and cinnamon, which lead into deep flavors of plums and preserved red fruits. A juicy but intense wine with a rich, velvety texture, excellent balance and firm tannins.

Ageing takes place for 7 months in 50% new French oak and 50% in second and third use American oak. 100% malolactic fermentation.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Juicy berry fruit aromas lead into concentrated flavors of raspberries and blackberries. Well-balanced with firm tannins. Hints of vanilla, cocoa and sweet oak appear on the finish.

Finished Alcohol: 13.5%

HARVEST & AGEING

The grapes for this wine are from the Tupungato Valley, 3,300 feet above sea level. They were harvested at peak maturity from our own vineyards, situated at the foot of the Andes mountain, a region that enjoys a wide day-to-night temperature variation. With the object of obtaining the greatest possible concentration without the extraction of dry tannins, the grapes for this wine were destemmed for a 20 day fermentation and maceration in new cone-shaped stainless steel tanks. The wine was then aged for 7 months in French oak, second use.

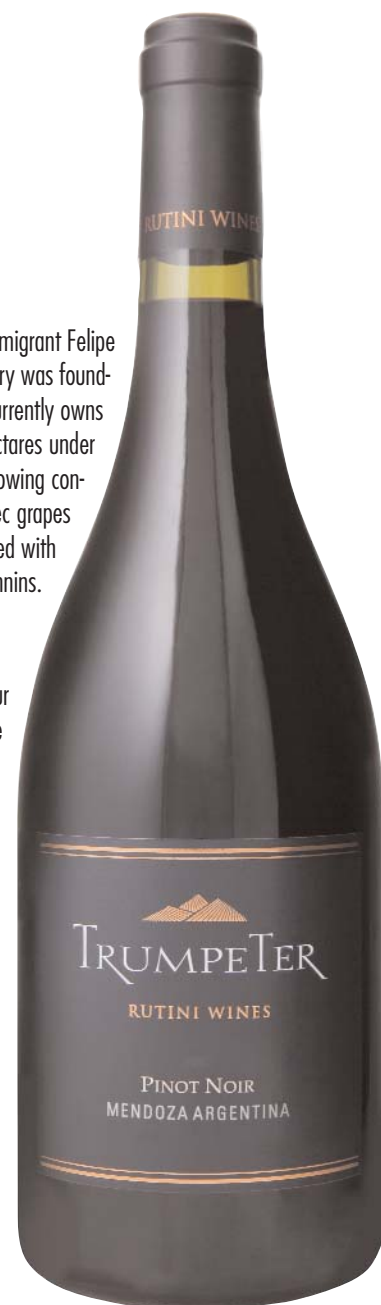
WINEMAKER'S NOTES

This Pinot Noir displays an intense ruby red hue. Fruity aromas of raspberries combine with hints of violet and oaky notes to create an elegant aromatic profile. The softness and fineness of the tannins give a silky, complex texture to the wine. This wine has been aged in French oak (second use) for 8 months.

A fragrant, floral nose with ripe peach aromas and a touch of rose and lychee. Fresh and smooth on the palate, with citrus fruit flavors, hints of minerals and a mild, pleasing acidity. A nicely balanced wine with a clean finish.

HARVEST & AGEING

The grapes are sourced from 13 year old vineyards in Tupungato, 1100 metres above sea level, Mendoza. The vines are trained using the vertical shoot positioning system and irrigated by drip irrigation. Soils in the area are mostly sandy. Yield is approximately 12,000 kgs per hectare. Grapes are hand-harvested. 30% barrel fermentation takes places for 7 months in 50% new French oak, 50% second and third use French oak. 30% Malolactic fermentation.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Aromas of rich tropical fruit lead into flavors of citrus fruits pineapple followed by a refreshingly crisp finish with hints of vanilla.

Grape Varieties: 100% Chardonnay

Finished Alcohol: 13.5%

Acidity/pH: 5.85g/l/3.42
